Meeting was called to order at 6:38 p.m.

Opening Prayer: Father Chris led the prayer

Minutes from the November meeting were reviewed and approved. Mary Kate moved to approve the minutes and Jen seconded.

Pastor's Report: Father Chris Dunlap

- Kudos to Jill Wenk and her committee for all their hard work with the Advent Glow. Father Chris reported that the event had representation from across the church.
- Father Chris reported that Saturday day is a Holy Day, Friday will be a candlelight vival, and that Advent by Tailgate will take place on Saturday beginning at 6:00 p.m.

- Mrs. Hoormann fielded questions regarding 1. Safety of students and 2. Communication with parents following the Catholic Supply shooting.
- Mrs. Hoormann reported that policies were followed, coordination with local police was slow initially, and that the safety of students was the utmost priority.
- Staff was reflective and reviewed all procedures in case of emergencies.
- School Counselor addressed basic issues related to the situation when students returned to school.
- Turkeys on Strike play went off successfully.
- The 3rd-5th Advent Play will be on December 11th. Mrs. Hoormann shared that the students demonstrated problem solving and critical thinking skills while preparing for the play.
- 8th Grade will be participating in Discovery Education's Twitter Feed – Physics of Flight. This can be followed on CPOP Science on Twitter. Mrs. Patton applied through Lockheed Martin and was accepted.
- 4th Grade Thanksgiving Mass will take place Friday.
- 3rd Grade is building robots which utilize real application of area and perimeter.
- Over 400 items/toys were picked up for the Toy Drive. A note accompanied the toys: Merry Christmas from Christ, Prince of Peace.
- In computer class students will be creating paper circuits. An ornament box of 3D created ornaments will be included in the upcoming Auction.
