All assignments are due to Mrs. Klein on the first day of school!

Assignment One:

Read a book of your own choosing. This may be any genre, but it must be an age-appropriate book that you have not yet read.

Be prepared to give a brief “Book Talk” about the book you read in hopes to inspire other readers to read the book, as well. You must bring written or typed notes to guide your presentation. You do NOT need to have the book with you during your presentation.

Items to be included in your Book Talk:

1. Title and author
2. Genre
3. Setting
4. Briefly describe the protagonist
5. Briefly explain the main conflict the character endures. No spoilers!
6. How would you rate the book on a scale from 1-10? Explain.
7. What kind of reader would enjoy this book? Explain.

Assignment Two:

Read a second book of your own choosing. This may be any genre, but it must be an age-appropriate book that you have not yet read.

Be prepared to give a brief “Book Talk” about the book you read in hopes to inspire other readers to read the book, as well. You must bring written or typed notes to guide your presentation; **these notes may be on the same page as the others.** You do NOT need to have the book with you during your presentation.

Items to be included in your Book Talk:

1. Title and author
2. Genre
3. Setting
4. Briefly describe the protagonist
5. Briefly explain the main conflict the character endures. No spoilers!
6. How would you rate the book on a scale from 1-10? Explain.
7. What kind of reader would enjoy this book? Explain.
